

Creating a FFA Agricultural Education Career Development Event as a Tool to Recruit More Teachers

Results to date:

- 8 Years
- 142 Participants
- 18 students enrolled into the Department of Agriculture Education and Communication at the University of Florida

How it works:

- Preliminary Test
- Preliminary Teaching Round.
- Final Teaching Round



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Costs:

- Biggest cost is time while recruiting judges for the contest.
- Paper costs and food costs in the form of pizza usually covered by department.

Advice to others:

- Consider the number of participants.
- Students should walk away with a positive attitude.
- Find a graduate student to manage scores on the event day
